- COVID PROTOCOL: Level 1 For Services, we are allowed 100 persons or less occupying NOT more than 50% of the capacity of the church space. We will continue physical distancing, washing our hands, and sanitising the church. You can sit 3 people per pew but only two in the side pews. You are encouraged to wear your mask throughout the service. Please do not remove the blue ribbon on the pew.
- FLOWER GUILD APPEAL: The Flower Guild is appealing for donations to enable them to beautify our church for Christmas. Any amount, no matter how small, will be highly appreciated.
- DEDICATION SUNDAY: As a result of churches being closed for so long, we will not be having a dedication service BUT will be sending out letters with a return slip attached. Parishioners are encouraged to indicate their Pledge for the ensuing year. This will help us in planning the Church finances. We do understand that with all the uncertainties it's difficult to make long term commitments, but we encourage Parishioners to indicate in FAITH. Dedication Letters will follow soon.
- CHRISTMAS SERVICES: As a result of COVID 19 Protocol we have had an audit of the Church building. We can accommodate 100 people safely and physically distanced. As an added safety and precautionary measure, it has been agreed to limit inside seating to 100 people, and to provide outside seating for 30 people, who might feel more comfortable outside. Please regard

this as an attempt to ensure a safe and joyous Christmas service. We will have 3 services, limited to 100 congregants per service. YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO REGISTER YOUR SERVICE OF CHOICE BY PHONING THE OFFICE BY NOT LATER THAN FRIDAY18 DECEMBER 2020
