As a Parish we continue to journey with the Letter of James and this week; we are faced with a familiar verse and probably the most quoted verse of the letter of James; "**So faith by itself, if it has no works, is dead**." As we reflect on this, let us seek to respond to the following:

- 1. What is your experience of Faith in action?
- 2. How have your experienced the grace of God, when living out your Faith?
- 3. What is your understanding of being saved/salvation?

My family and I continue to pray and give thanks for this season of our lives, as we navigate the beautiful moments experienced here at St. Saviour's, encountering loving, gracious and caring Parishioners. May you be blessed and please continue to pray for me, as I continue to pray for you.
