Dear Friends and Family of St. Saviour's. Greetings!

For many weeks now, we have been challenged as Parish to be intentional about our prayers and discerning that which God has called us to as a community. I have become so aware that we are on the cusp of something exciting, and the Lord is calling on us to be obedient. This awareness up until a few days ago has caused me a bit of restlessness, as I could sense there was something happening, I just did not know what it was and how it will be expressed.

In trying to discern for myself what it is that God is calling our Parish to and preparing us for that which God has in store for us, we birthed a Tuesday morning contemplative prayer service adding to our worship options, creating a space for personal prayer in a communal space. In addition we recently convened a Worship Workshop, for all role players in Sunday morning services, this is where I was challenged to hear what God is calling us to.

A few brave young people and not so young people voiced their concern about the future of our Church in relation to our expression of worship, particularly around matters pertaining to music. There was an overwhelming feeling that if we are to be a forward looking and all welcoming Church, one of the aspects of our beautiful worship that would need attention is our liturgical music. This was not in any way suggesting the throwing out of that which is our identity, but rather looking at ways by which our identity can be more inclusive. To this extent a worship committee has been formed, to spend time specifically looking at how we can explore various forms and genres of music in our Sunday morning service.

The Change we have been praying about and the listening to that which God is calling us to, is slowly beginning to become visible, and part of our response, is one of obedience, listening to the voice of God. So, over the next few weeks and months we will be experimenting with the music in our Church and please, I invite you to offer suggestions/feedback/concerns directly to me, as we together are inheritors of the Kingdom of God, through our baptism.

I will be away on retreat this week, so please pray with me and for me and pray for the safety of my family in my absence.
