I am the Good Shepherd...

Eastertide greetings friends and family.

As a community we continue to celebrate the gift of the resurrected Christ, who calls us to experience afresh and anew this wonderful gift of new life. As we celebrate the gift of the resurrection, we are today met with a beautiful illustration of a Jesus who walks this journey with us, a Jesus who affirms; I AM THE GOOD SHEPHERD. This is probably one of the gentlest titles one can give oneself, conjures up an image of a prayer I prayed as a toddler.

"Gentle Jesus, meek and mild, look upon a little child; Pity my simplicity, suffer me to come to Thee."

Pope Francis reminds us, "a shepherd needs to smell like his sheep" ... In order to smell like one's sheep, their needs to be constant and ongoing interaction between Sheep and Shepherd, their needs to be a level of intimacy, their needs to be an understand of identity and the expression thereof.

It was Archbishop Desmond Tutu who familiarised and popularised the Anglican Church with the concept of UBUNTU; I am because you are. This too like the saying of Jesus, is an I AM statement. However, what the concept of UBUNTU reminds us that my identity lies in my understanding expression of your identity.

Today as we reflect on the identity of Jesus as the Good Shepherd, we challenged to offer our own I AM statement. Again our personal I AM statement ought to be one which encapsulates and embraces the identity of the other, for we do not live in vacuum, as a Easter people, we are part of the resurrected community, and so we have a communal identity, an identity which acknowledges the pain and suffering of the cross, an identity which recognises the darkness and loneliness of the tomb, but as always; an identity which has experienced the power of God's love, to raise Jesus to new life.

May we open ourselves to follow the Good Shepherd, may we recognise who we are through appreciating the humanity of the other, may we love and care, as the Good Shepherd calls us too.
